... but they haven't really tried yet either.

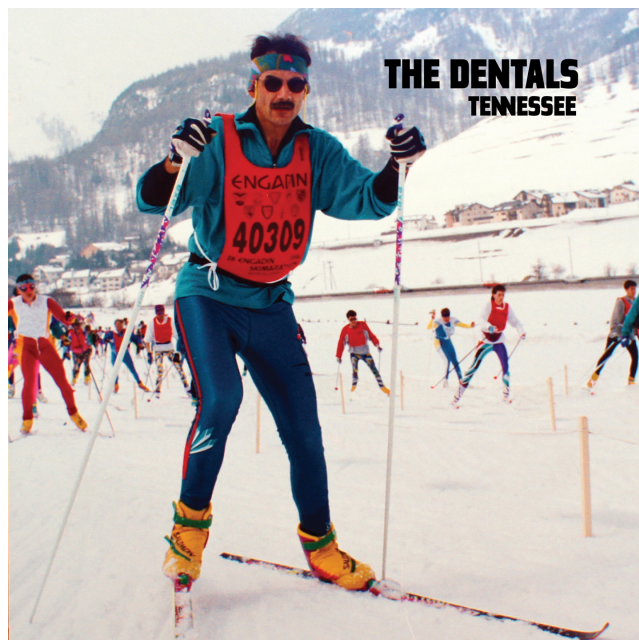

THE BAND:

The Dentals are an incredibly good looking indie-pop group that formed in 2002 in the waiting room of a dentist. Four years later their song "Mary Wants To Marry Me" became a little hit as it reached the number 1 spot in the Hong Kong download-charts where it stayed for several weeks. Since then more people have joined the band and the music has slowly transformed to a much more relaxing, quiet indie-pop sound.

Most of their tunes are acoustic, cheerful and extremely catchy and they sound a bit like a slightly less talented but more diverse version of the Lucksmiths. Growing up with 90ies indie bands like Weezer, Pavement or Teenage Fanclub has left its mark on song writing. The Dentals sound however is more reminiscent of bands like Fountains of Wayne, Death Cab for Cutie, Nada Surf or They Might Be Giants.
